Military Record of JEREMIAH PERRY 2nd NORTH CAROLINA RECT. REVOLUTIONARY WAR. PRIVATE ON A ROLL OF CAPTAIN JOHN INGLE'S COMPANY 2ND NORTH CAROLINA BATTALION, COMMANDED BY COL. JOHN PATTEN. ENLISTED APRIL 29, 1776. ROLL DATED SEPTEMBER 9, 1778.

THIS DOESN'T TELL WHEN HE WAS DISCHARGED BUT IT DOES SHOW THAT HE SERVED ABOUT 2-1/2 YEARS AND PORBABLY LONGER IN THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR. IF SOMEONE IS INTERESTED IN D.A.R., HERE IS A GOOD REFERENCE.

AUNT MOLLY'S JAM CAKE RECIPE

2 cups sugar	6 eggs
1 cup shortening	1 cup cold coffee
4 cups flour	3 Tbs. cocoa
3 t soda in coffee	
1 ice tea glass blackberry jam	
1 ice tea glass cherry preserves	
1 ice tea glass strawberry preserves	
1 ice tea glass watermellon rind preserves	
1 t vanilla	
1 t mace	
1 heaping tsp. cinnamon	
1 glass nuts	
2 boxes white raisins	

Mix as other jamcakes, bake in greased pan at 300°. Don't let cake dry out. It should be waxy. Use white cream or Caramel icing. This is a large cake and Oh-so-good.....
